European Union to revise the Code of practice for the prevention and reduction of dioxins and dioxin-like PCBs in Food and Feed (CAC/RCP 62-2006) for consideration by CCCF12 in 2018 (REP17/CF, paras 144 – 149,

Appendix IX).

The revision is aimed at updating the COP with new available management practices to contain contamination of dioxins and dioxin-like PCBs, including mitigation measures for non-dioxin like PCBs, in food and feed, following the outcome of the JECFA80 evaluation of NDL-PCBs and new developments in science and technology in relation to containment of dioxins and DL-PCBs.
