Description of work	 CCPR50 agreed the EWG will: Continue the work on the revision of Class C, Animal Feed Commodities, based on the structure provided in REP50/PR, Appendix X. Consider the proposal to add subgroups to the groups that would include processed commodities (including the possible relocation of commodities from Class D to Class C). Consider new commodities for Class C. Initiate work on Type 12 Secondary food commodities of plant origin in Class D. Assign codes to miscellaneous commodities. Following the recommendation of CCEXEC73 (2017)¹ on closer cooperation between CCPR and CCRVDF on issues of mutual interest for compounds used as both pesticides and veterinary drugs and the exploration of innovative ways to foster such collaboration as well as the discussions and decisions of CCPR50 (2018)² and CCRVDF24 (2018)³ in this regard, CCEXEC75 (2018)⁴ made a joint recommendation to the CCPR/EWG on the revision of the Classification and the CCRVDF/EWG on the definition of edible animal tissues that, in addition to their existing terms of reference, both EWGs will: work closely on the definition of MRLs for pesticides and veterinary drugs.
